

**City of Smith Center**  
**City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**February 11, 2016**  
**7:00 pm**

The City Council met in regular session at 7:00pm with Mayor Bryce Wiehl presiding. Council members present: Dave Mace, Adam Rentschler and Chris Cole. Absent: Lynn Zierlein and Jason Baetz.
