

City of Smith Center
City Council Meeting Minutes
June 9th, 2016
7:00 pm

The City Council met in regular session at 7:00pm with Mayor Bryce Wiehl presiding. Council members present: Jason Baetz, Chris Cole, Lynn Zierlein, and Dave Mace. Absent: Adam Rentschler.

Others present: Rob Roudybush, Harve Newlin, Bill Phillips, Jamie Marshall, and Jill Conaway.

Motion by Zierlein, seconded by Cole to approve the minutes of the May 26, 2016 meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Cole, seconded by Baetz to approve payment of the monthly expenses. Motion carried.

Hall Brothers: A presentation was given by Rob Roudybush and Harve Newlin on Onyx, a frictional mastic surface treatment for roadways. Council members asked various questions of the product such as the durability, cost, process of application, etc. Hall Brothers will be applying the Onyx nearby and will be in contact with the city office at that time.

Airport Hangar Lease: After some discussion, the council will direct the city attorney to review and update the current airport hangar lease agreement to better define situations where a hangar is leased for purposes other than airplane storage. The new lease agreement will be reviewed at the June 23, 2016 council meeting.

Airport Hangars: The council asked that a quote be obtained for the cost to repaint the T-hangars at the airport.

Airport Hangar Door: Discussion was held on door options for hangar #13. Motion by Zierlein, seconded by Baetz to replace the door on hangar #13, based on the estimate received from Maxwell Welding & Repair. Motion carried.

Public Transportation Program: Motion by Baetz, seconded by Cole to hire Dennis Hansen as a part-time public transportation driver. Motion carried.

Superintendents Reports: Marshall has received word that the new patrol car is in. Once all of the documentation is complete, the car will be picked up. Marshall reported on various tickets given since the last council meeting.

Phillips reported on street maintenance in progress.

Councilmember Reports: Zierlein shared information on pump issues at the golf course that have been remedied.

Discussion was held among the councilmembers on the city's grass and limb dump site. Clarification was made that only grass and tree limbs can be left at the site, no trash bags, concrete, trash, etc.; and that tree limbs must be less than 12 inches in diameter.

Cole commended Phillips and crew on the street work taking place.

Motion by Baetz, seconded by Zierlein to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:23pm.
